MESSAGE FROM PASTOR GREG......

Have you ever heard of liminal space? It's a fancy way of talking about when you are in-between two different things. Grossnickle Church is in a liminal space in a number of ways. In-between permanent pastors, most notably. In this liminal space we are still processing with one another, still healing. But that's not the only liminal space the church is in. Like all churches, we're still transitioning out of COVID times. Some are just now getting comfortable in large groups of people, the makeup of congregations has changed for a number of reasons, and we're adapting to do things in different ways.

Liminal space is scary because "we've never been here before." At the same time, liminal space is also an incredible opportunity for growth. Memorable Biblical liminal spaces: Jesus' 40 days in the desert, times when he retreated to the mountain or sea, and the time after Jesus' ascension when the disciples were figuring out where they were called next....the list can go on and on.

It's okay to be in liminal space for a time. At our best, when we come out of it, we have clearer direction, deeper commitment, and are ready to adapt to what comes next.

One great example of coming out of this transitory time was this last month at Vacation Bible School. The leaders did not know what to expect in our first real VBS since COVID. Volunteers and families had fallen out of the habit, and even forgot the joy and blessing of the event. In spite of these unknowns and challenges those leaders moved forward into the unknown, adapted as needed, and created an incredible ministry event!

May God continue to bless us in these important times in the life of our congregation!

OUTREACH SUMMER PROJECT

The Growing Project held their Blessing of the Seed service on Sunday, June 11 at the Growing Project farm. Our Growing Project is now in its 18th year; we support the efforts of Growing Hope Globally, an international foods security organization that funds smallholder agricultural programs in developing countries all around the world. Our funds are raised by generous folks who support an acre of land to grow crops locally. The money raised is then designated for an overseas program each year. In the past 18 years, our Growing Project has raised nearly \$500,000 and it is estimated that we have brought over 7000 people out of hunger to a place where they can support themselves. About the Tanzania Arusha Program

In 2021, Convoy of Hope worked with 408 women in the Arusha Region to help them farm a half acre of maize each. Through the provision of seed, fertilizer, pesticides, and technical assistance, each farmer saw exponential increase in their productivity and profitability. Average harvest was 1,000 kg of maize per ½ acre, whereas previous harvests in the area averaged 250-

500 kg per ½ acre. Due to this success, Convoy of Hope is extending this program to assist a greater population throughout the Arusha Region. In 2022 the number of participants increased to approximately 600 women. Subsequent years will also increase the number of participants by about 50%.
